We offer essential services to promote health and well-being in the Wajir community. Each programme is designed to meet women and vulnerable groups where they are and to build lasting community resilience.

Health Education

We provide vital health education on HIV prevention, reproductive health, and personal safety, empowering the community to make informed health decisions through continuous education on critical health topics.

Treatment Literacy

Our treatment literacy initiatives improve retention in care by educating clients about ART adherence, clinic attendance, and the importance of consistent medication utilization.

Psychosocial Support

We offer counseling services and peer support groups to help combat stigma and provide emotional assistance to those facing discrimination and mental health challenges.

Referrals and Linkages

We facilitate connections to health facilities for HIV testing, STI treatment, legal aid, and economic empowerment opportunities to enhance community welfare.
